Description of Duties: The North Carolina Alliance for Public Health Agencies is accepting applications for a part time (3-4 days per week) licensed Physical Therapist (PT) or Physical Therapy Assistant (PTA). These contract positions will provide physical therapy services to patients in their homes for both home health and hospice programs at the Dare County Department of Public Health.

Education and Experiences Requirements:

Physical Therapist- Graduation from an accredited school of physical therapy and two years of physical therapy experience in a specialty field of work to which assigned; or a master's degree in physical therapy and one year of physical therapy experience in a specialty field of work to which assigned; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Licensure as a Physical Therapist in North Carolina. Experience in public and/or community health desirable.

Physical Therapy Assistant- Completion of an approved two-year school for physical therapy assistants and two years of experience in home health; or graduation from high school and three years of on-the-job training in the administration of physical therapy treatments including instruction in anatomy, physiology, and skeletal biomechanics and two years of experience in area of specialty; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Licensed as a Physical Therapist Assistant in North Carolina.

Pre-employment drug testing and a valid NC driver's license are required. Appropriate professional licensure required.
